

## Number of Dead or Sick Animals Reported

This table uses data reported on the Sick or Dead Bird and Mammal on-line reporting form for the current reporting period (April 1 - March 31).

This data is used to detect trends in mortality. Along with the laboratory test results, this data helps establish a normal wildlife mortality baseline that may help determine if an outbreak of WNV is occurring. Use of the data may help determine which species of birds or mammals are most susceptible and most resistant to WNV.
