### TRAVEL SCAMS

It's only natural that as the weather begins to warm, thoughts turn to traveling. Here are some tips to keep in mind when planning your vacation:

- When making reservations, get a written confirmation;
- Make sure you know what you are buying *before* you buy;
- Make sure you know what is included in the cost of your cruise or other "all inclusive" vacations *before* you book;
- Make sure you are familiar with cancellation policies *before* you book;
- Make sure you read and understand all documents before signing!
