Pursuant to P.A. 200 of 2012

Training Report for Staff with Youthful Offenders

By April 1, 2013 the department shall report to the senate and house appropriations subcommittees on corrections, the senate and house fiscal agencies, and the state budget director on the training curriculum used and the number and types of staff receiving training under such curriculum since October 2009.

Youthful Offender Training is for staff assigned to the housing unit for youthful offenders at the Thumb Correctional Facility. Since October 2009, sixty three (63) staff has attended the training and the breakdown is as follows:
