Pursuant to P.A. 124 of 2007

Section 407.(2)

**Offenders Who Have Served Their Maximum Sentence and Have Been Released From Prison
May 2008**

Section 407.(2) of 2007 P.A. 124 requires that the Department of Corrections provide monthly reports on offenders who have served their maximum sentence and have been released from prison in May 2008:

(a) *The number of offenders who were paroled and returned to prison prior to serving their maximum sentence compared to the number of offenders who served their maximum sentence without ever having been paroled.*

- 47 Prior Parole
- 119 Without ever having been paroled

(b) *The number of offenders disaggregated by major offense type: assaultive, nonassaultive, drug, and sex.*

* 52 offenders were serving only for a Felony Firearm (750.227BA) which has a flat sentence without parole

NOTE: The column *Historical Number of Adjudication Instances* applies to each column to the right. For example, reading down the Juvenile Commitment column, out of the 166 maxouts in May 2008, 136 had no Juvenile Commitment, 17 had one Juvenile Commitment, 6 had two, 3 had three, 3 had four ,... and none had more than six
