

**REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE**  
**Pursuant to P.A. 245 of 2008 Section 403(6)**  
**MPRI Parolees Tested Positive for Substances and Department Imposed Sanctions**  
**March 2009 - August 2009**

*Section 403(6) of 2008 P.A. 245* requires that the Department of Corrections provide biannual reports on parolees who participated in the MPRI and have tested positive for substances in the previous 6 months. The report shall include any sanctions imposed by the department in response to the positive substance test.
