

REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE
Pursuant to Public Act 207 of 2018
Article V, Section 816
Health Care – Pharmaceutical Expenditures

Sec. 816. By April 1, the department shall provide the senate and house appropriations subcommittees on corrections, the senate and house fiscal agencies, the legislative ombudsman, and the state budget office with a report on pharmaceutical expenditures and prescribing practices. In particular, the report shall provide the following information:

(a) A detailed accounting of expenditures on antipsychotic medications.

Year-to-Date expenditures for antipsychotic medications for October 2018 to February 2019 are \$1,043,977.34. The monthly breakdown of expenditures is:

October 2018	\$230,665.92
November 2018	\$211,690.65
December 2018	\$207,229.27
January 2019	\$207,580.33
February 2019	\$186,811.17

Fiscal Year 2018 (October 2017-September 2018) antipsychotic medication expenditures totaled \$2,376,586.78.

(b) Any changes that have been made to the prescription drug formularies.

The Michigan Department of Corrections, Bureau of Health Care Services maintains a Clinical Formulary reference book which was first approved on September 20, 2006 and most recently updated on February 27, 2019. The Clinical Formulary has been updated 4 times during the 2018-2019 Fiscal year. These occurred on October 17, 2018, November 14, 2018, December 12, 2018, and February 27, 2019.
