

**REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE Pursuant to Public Act 268 of 2016**  
**Article V, Section 816**  
**Health Care – Pharmaceutical Expenditures**

Sec. 816. By April 1, the department shall provide the members of the senate and house appropriations subcommittees on corrections, the senate and house fiscal agencies, the state budget director, and the legislative corrections ombudsman with a report on pharmaceutical expenditures and prescribing practices. In particular, the report shall provide the following information:

(a) A detailed accounting of expenditures on antipsychotic medications.

Year-to-Date expenditures for antipsychotic medications for October 2016 to February 2017 are \$1,594,699.12. The monthly breakdown of expenditures is:

October 2016	\$353,097.83
November 2016	\$349,167.14
December 2016	\$326,088.47
January 2017	\$292,442.27
February 2017	\$273,903.41

Fiscal Year 2016 (October 2015-September 2016) antipsychotic medication expenditures totaled 3,811,838.23.

(b) Any changes that have been made to the prescription drug formularies.

The Michigan Department of Corrections, Bureau of Health Care Services maintains a Clinical Formulary reference book which was first approved on September 20, 2006 and most recently updated on February 22, 2017. The Clinical Formulary has been updated 8 times during the 2016-2017 Fiscal year. These occurred on October 1, 2016, October 17, 2016, November 4, 2016, November 16, 2016, December 7, 2016, December 14, 2016, January 25, 2017 and February 22, 2017.
