Electronic Waste, Part 173 Update

STATUS

62 electronics manufacturers have paid the registration fee.

14 ewaste recyclers have paid the registration fee.

58 of the manufacturer registrations are administratively complete.

All 14 of the recyclers are administratively complete.

Manufacturers and recyclers have been informed of their status (administratively complete or administratively incomplete).

The list of administratively complete registrations and scanned versions of the registrations are available online.

Letters informing retailers of their obligations will be sent in July to retailers that are currently selling unregistered electronic devices.

Letters to unregistered manufacturers selling covered electronic devices will be sent in July.

TIMELINE

Signed into law	December 29, 2008
Recyclers register and pay \$2,000 annual fee by	October 30, 2009
Manufacturers register and pay \$3,000 annual fee by	October 30, 2009
Manufacturers may not sell TVs and Computers unless registered and labeled	April 1, 2010
Retailers may not sell TVs and computers unless on registered list	April 1, 2010
Manufactures of TVs and Computers must have a takeback program	April 1, 2010
Manufacturers and recyclers to register for next fiscal year	October 30, 2010
Printers added	April 1, 2011
