**FINAL DECISION**

On November 9, 2009, Chief Deputy Commissioner Stephen R. Hilker issued an Order for Hearing in this case. The Order for Hearing set forth detailed allegations that Respondent had engaged in conduct which made him ineligible to be licensed as a nonresident insurance producer under the Michigan Insurance Code (MCL 500.100, *et seq.*). The Order required Respondent to take one of the following actions within 21 days: agree to a resolution of the case, file an answer to the allegations stated in the Order with a statement that Respondent plans to attend the hearing, or request an adjournment. Respondent failed to take any of these actions.


On January 6, 2010, the Petitioner filed a Motion for Final Decision. Given Respondent's failure to take one of the required actions, Petitioner's motion is granted.

**FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. The Respondent, Jeffrey Hess, is a Michigan licensed nonresident producer with qualifications in accident, health and life.
2. On September 23, 1993 in Tennessee, the Respondent was convicted of a felony, theft of property valued at between \$1,000 and \$10,000.
3. Having been convicted of a felony, Respondent is not qualified to hold an insurance producer license in Michigan.

**ORDER**

In accordance with section 1239 and 1244 of the Michigan Insurance Code,  
Respondent's insurance producer license is revoked.
