SUMMARY: The Office of Retirement Services (ORS) provides employee retirement and related retiree health care plans for over 580,000 of Michigan's state employees, public school employees, judges and state police. ORS administers four defined benefit pension plans, two defined contribution pension plans, and one defined benefit plus defined contribution plan, all of which are promulgated in State statutes.

Each system has a Retirement Board which provides oversight and general policy guidance.
