SUBJECT: State-Owned Mineral Rights.

APPLICATION: Executive Branch Departments and Sub-units.

PURPOSE: To provide proper control for removal of and compensation for state-owned mineral rights.

SUMMARY: If approached by an individual or mineral industry representative to remove, explore for, or develop minerals on lands you occupy or manage, contact the DNR. Only the DNR is authorized to enter into leases, permits, or agreements for removal of state-owned minerals.
