

**1710.22 Environmental Permit Coordination**

Issued: February 1, 2008  
Revised: February 23, 2012

**SUBJECT:** Environmental Requirements.

**APPLICATION:** Executive Branch Departments and Sub-units.

**PURPOSE:** To assure that all projects are conducted under the authority of proper environmental permits (or approvals of a permit-like nature) to prevent impacts to public health or the environment in accordance with environmental law and to ensure that personnel obtain required certifications necessary to competently manage environmental operations.

**CONTACT AGENCY:** Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ)  
Permit Coordination Program

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**SUMMARY:** The following laws require projects or activities be conducted in accordance with a permit from the Department of Environmental Quality or require persons to be certified or otherwise licenses to perform various duties:

Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, PA 451 of 1994, as amended.  
Safe Drinking Water Act, PA 399 of 1976, as amended.  
Public Health Code, PA 368 of 1978, as amended.  
The Mobile Home Commission Act, PA 96 of 1987, as amended.  
Land Division Act, PA 28 of 1967, as amended.  
Hazardous Materials Transportation Act, PA 138 of 1998, as amended.

**PROCEDURES:**

Review the permit program screening questions found in the Permit Information Checklist to determine relevancy of DEQ permit programs. The checklist contains “yes” and “no” questions that help identify the types of activities at the proposed facility or project that may require permits from DEQ.
