PURPOSE

If a state or local agency is concerned about compliance with MIOSHA safety and health standards, it may request consultation assistance from the Consultation Education & Training (CET) Division. Each department has a Safety and Health Coordinator, who should be contacted about requesting assistance from the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA).
