Right-To-Know

Executive Branch Departments and Sub-units shall comply with applicable statutory and regulatory provisions concerning the maintenance and communication of information to state employees about hazardous work place material.

Michigan Right-To-Know Law, Public Act 80 of 1986, which encompasses the Federal Hazard Communication Standard, CFR 1910.1200, amendment to Public Act 154 of 1974 (MIOSHA).
