

29. How has Michigan or other jurisdictions proposed addressing possible impacts from the adoption of a federal RPS?

The legislature contemplated a federal RPS when developing Michigan's RPS. Section 41 of Act 295 specifies that a renewable energy credit used to comply with a federal RPS may also be used to comply with Act 295.

The Michigan Renewable Energy Certification System is flexible and has the ability to exchange RECs with other REC tracking systems including the North American Renewable Registry. Administratively, due to this flexibility, federal RPS activities could likely be incorporated into Michigan's RPS process.
