

**Summary of City of Flint (City) Actions
In Response to the
EPA Emergency Administrative Order
Updated: February 12, 2016**

Chapter 53b: Water Testing Results for the City Since January 2013.

EPA Order Due Date: 01/31/2016

In 2013, monitoring for lead did not occur, as the City of Flint (City) was purchasing treated water from Detroit Water & Sewer Department and was on a reduced monitoring schedule that occurred every three years.

In 2014, the City conducted a six (6) month round of regulatory sampling from July 1st – December 31st while treating water from the Flint River.

In 2015, the City of Flint conducted a second six (6) month round of regulatory sampling for lead and copper from January 1st – June 30th.

The City continued offering lead & copper sampling free of charge to all residents after June 30, 2015 for the remainder of the calendar year.

The State of Michigan/Department of Environmental Quality began assisting the City with sampling and testing in the fall of 2015.

Lead & copper monitoring has continued throughout the City into 2016, and daily results are posted on the State of Michigan's "Taking Action on Flint Water" website.
