Part 3 - Signature of Licensee

The licensee shall comply with the provisions of MCL 436.1537(2)-MCL 436.1537(5) when conducting a beer and wine tasting event.

The licensee must submit the Beer & Wine Tasting Event Notification form (LCC-257) at least ten (10) business days prior to conducting a beer and wine tasting event.

A beer and wine tasting event may only be conducted during the legal hours for the sale of alcoholic beverages by the licensee. Samples are not to be offered to, or allowed to be consumed by, any person under the legal age for consuming alcoholic liquor.

A consumer may not be charged for the tasting of beer or wine. Each consumer is limited to 3 samples within a twenty-four hour period per licensed premises. The samples shall not exceed 3 ounces per serving of beer or 2 ounces of per serving of wine.

The permit holder must demonstrate that the person conducting the beer and wine tasting event has successfully completed the server training program in the manner provided for in section 906 and rules promulgated by the Commission and the person conducting the beer and wine tasting event shall devote full time to the beer and wine tasting event activity and shall perform no other duties, including the sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption off the licensed premises.

The beer and wine used for the tasting event must come from the Specially Designated Merchant's inventory. All open bottles must be removed from the premises on the same business day or resealed and stored in a locked, separate storage compartment on the licensed premises when not being used for the activities allowed by the permit.

A wholesaler shall not conduct or participate in beer and wine tastings.
