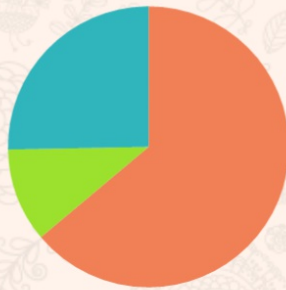

Library Collections

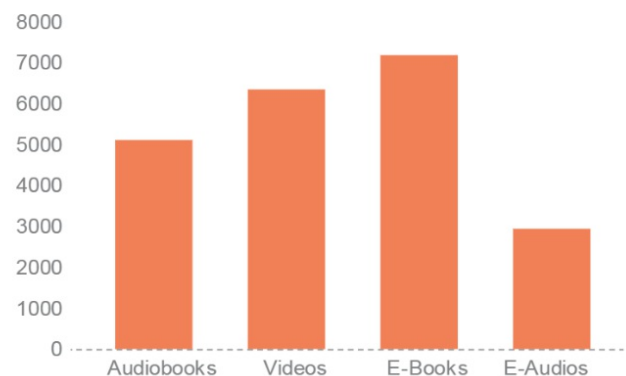
Michigan libraries maintain a print collection of over 32 million materials for Michigan residents. They also offer the following.
