Re: Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act Notice

Dear Ms. Canfora:

This notice is being provided pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act ("WARN") and for purposes limited to WARN only. Chrysler Group LLC will idle its North Engine Plant at 2000 Van Horn Rd., Trenton, Michigan in May 2011. As a result, it is anticipated that employment losses of up to approximately 464 employees working at the Trenton North Engine Plant will begin on or about May 6, 2011 or within 14 days thereafter. These actions are expected to be permanent.

Attached to this notice is a layoff summary report. There may be "bumping rights" with respect to this layoff. Employees may have layoff benefits available to them through their applicable collective bargaining agreements or company-sponsored benefits plans, if eligible.
