#### Introduction

English Learner (EL) students are those students who are acquiring proficiency in the English Language. This document lists, describes, provides links to, and shows the availability of the various reporting and data tools offered to support EL students. Additionally, the last two sections of this document provide state of Michigan websites and contact information that can be used to get more information about the supports provided to EL students in Michigan.
