<p>SEOW Meeting Approval of Agenda/Minutes - J. Hoepfner</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Agenda for today's meeting was reviewed and approved by consensus. The minutes of January 20, 2016 were reviewed with one correction; Rachel Kollin was not present.	
<p>Update on Next Steps/Action Items from Previous Meeting – J. Hoepfner</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Disparities in High Need Communities Discussion.➤ Marijuana and traffic crash link through Dianne Perukel.➤ Death Data 2014 (Opioid and Heroin).	
<p>OROSC Updates – Larry Scott</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Larry announced that there are no new updates and gave the platform to Su Min.➤ LARA Data – Su Min talks about the working relationship with Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA) and their assistance with the pilot program for the Governor's task force on prescription drugs. Provided a list of 2014 overdose decedents to overlay with the MAPS data to identify prescribers in the state. This list included the type of drug involved; opioids, heroin, benzodiazepine, sedatives and psycho stimulants based on the death certificate files. In exchange for this data, LARA will provide us with a list of over prescribers by county.	
<p>Emerging Issues and Trends</p> <p>Opioids, Prescription Drugs, Heroin, Marijuana, E-Cigarettes - Su Min Oh</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Prescription Drugs – Su Min says nothing from the Governor's Task Force has been received. Marie from Region two (2) added that over 60 law enforcement officers have been trained to administer Naloxone. Tracking of incident data are being researched. Joel says they are looking into a dashboard. Joel asks if anyone has a dataset to please share with Su Min, which we will discuss in future meetings. The Bureau of EPI is looking into statewide data.➤ Heroin – See below: <i>Data Updates: Drug Overdose Deaths, PFS2015 Health Disparities</i>➤ Legalizing Marijuana – Three (3) bills that were passed by the House of Representatives in early October are still waiting to be reviewed by the Senate Judiciary committee – No movement.➤ E-cigarettes – No new information nor movement since October 2015.➤ Alcohol – The Powdered Alcohol fact sheet has been updated and is on the OROSC website. The fact sheet link is http://www.michigan.gov/documents/mdch/Palcohol_Fact_Sheet-R_490829_7.pdf. CDC funding opportunity was announced to promote population health through increased capacity in alcohol epidemiology. Michigan has been one of the two states that received the funding. Currently, no alcohol epidemiologist on board. Will check with Sarah on the alcohol epidemiology program and let her know there are additional findings available.➤ Behavioral Health Indicators Development - Checked with Corinne and she has not been able to participate due to other issues and therefore could not provide any updates
