The purpose of the Commission is to advise state agencies on initiatives to improve the efficiency and cost effectiveness of supply chain management for businesses. The Advisory Committee is comprised of nine (9) members and makes recommendations to the Michigan Strategic Fund Board regarding projects related to port facilities.
