

M-46 Culvert Replacement Sanilac County

What Is Being Done?


The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is investing \$815,000 to replace the M-46 culvert over the Middle Branch of the Cass River. This project includes resurfacing the bridge approaches and upgrading rail. Crews will also be improving portions of the approved detour route along North Sandusky Road.

This project will bring the culvert up to current standards, improving overall safety. Work is being scheduled to

accommodate local county projects and occur during a time of estimated low water levels ideal for safe and efficient replacement.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

Traffic will be detoured via M-46, using M-19, Snover Road, and North Sandusky Road.
