WHAT:

An open house-style meeting to gather public input on the future I-94 Modernization Project in Detroit.

BACKGROUND:

The I-94 Modernization Project involves rebuild 6.7 miles of the freeway from the I-94/I-96 interchange to east of Conner Avenue. The project will improve public safety, bolster the economy and modernize the freeway, originally built more than 50 years ago. MDOT is looking for community input that will help complete the project's conceptual design. Areas for public input include continuous service drives, local bridges and aesthetics (lighting, landscaping, etc.) New traffic data and the plans for an additional lane will also be discussed.
