

# US-127/I-496

## Critical Bridge Maintenance and Repairs

### Lansing

#### Summer-Winter 2021

### What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will invest approximately \$1.3 million to perform emergency maintenance and repairs on 11 bridges along US-127 and I-496 in Lansing.

### When Will This Be Done?

Work is expected to begin in late summer and is expected to be finished in early winter.

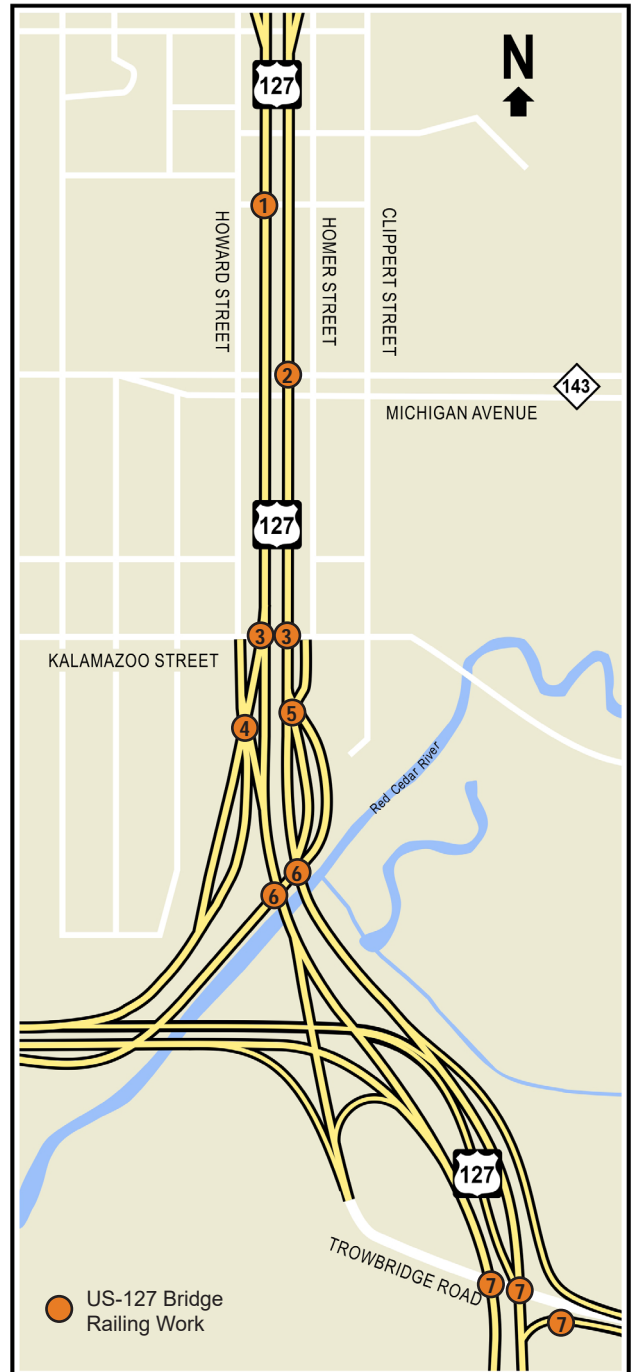
### How Will Traffic Be Affected?

Drivers should expect single-lane closures on US-127 and I-496 during staging and bridge work.

Ramp and local road lane closures will be staged to limit the impact on traffic for the following bridge locations:

- ① Vine Street under US-127,
- ② Michigan Avenue under US-127,
- ③ Kalamazoo Street under US-127,
- ④ The southbound US-127 ramp to westbound I-496,
- ⑤ The eastbound I-496 ramp to northbound US-127,
- ⑥ Northbound and southbound US-127 over the Red Cedar River, and
- ⑦ Trowbridge Road under US-127 and the northbound US-127 ramp to Trowbridge Road.

The exact dates for these ramp closures will be announced in advance.
