During my time at C. M. H. I have had four different therapists. I feel that I was effected each time I had to change. I was most effected when the therapist, Millie Patterson, I was working with for quite a while was let go. I knew she would be leaving as she told me this. I had two more appointments with her, but when I showed up for the first one, I was told she was gone already and I was assigned a new therapist, lucky for me it was one I had in the past. I feel that I was dealt a heavy blow to my treatment because I did not get closure when my therapist was let go and I did not get to say goodbye. I felt like I was starting over again, trying to form a bond with my new

therapist, to be open and truthful about myself.

During my treatment, I was referred to a program for employment. I was referred to Dean Ernsberger. There was a lot of miscommunication about this program and it was no benefit to me. It caused me to have a lot of hope for helping me find employment but with all the misunderstanding about the program nothing ever came to be. This was because it was a new program that is still under developed. I also found the same thing from Michigan Rehabilitation Services. My time and gas was spent to go to these appointments and never got any benefits for them.

I have been under the care of Dr. Barry Binkley for my entire time I have been receiving care at C. M. H. I have found him to be a highly respectable doctor. I find his compassion to my problems and his knowledge of the medications and their side effects very valuable to me and my recovery. He is very knowledgeable and a great asset to C. M. H.

I have also dealt with the children services offered from C. M. H. My wife and I did not find them very helpful to my child and had the case closed after only a short period of time. I feel that the children's services need to be looked at and changed for the better.
