**ORDER EXTENDING CONDITIONAL TEMPORARY
THIRD-PARTY FACILITATOR LICENSE**

On September 3, 2020, Churchill Downs Technology Initiatives Company was granted a conditional temporary third-party license which expired 30 days from issuance. On October 3, 2020, an order was issued to extend the conditional license by 60 days. As necessary, a second extension is now ordered to extend the conditional temporary license for 6 months from December 2, 2020.

As permitted by 8(1)(d)(vi)(A) of the Horse Racing Law of 1995 (Act), MCL 431.308(1)(d)(A), the temporary third-party facilitator license is extended for an additional 6 months. Churchill Downs must still comply with the Act, the Administrative Rules, and the Order Establishing Terms, Conditions, and Fees for Third Party Facilitators issued on September 3, 2020. The Executive Director may issue sanctions including, but not limited to, revocation or suspension of a license, exclusion from racetrack grounds, or a fine.
