ORDER GRANTING A CONDITIONAL THIRD-PARTY FACILITATOR LICENSE
NYRAbets, LLC (NYRAbets) filed an application for a third-party facilitator license in accordance with the Horse Racing Law of 1995 (Act), MCL 431.301 to MCL 431.336, and the Horse Racing General Rules (Rules), Mich Admin Code R 431.1001 through 431.5040.
As permitted by § 8(1)(d)(vi)(A) of the Act, MCL 431.308(1)(d)(vi)(A), NYRAbets is granted a conditional TPF license which is valid until December 31, 2022, or until one of the following happens: (1) NYRAbets' joint contract expires or is terminated; (2) the conditional license is suspended or revoked; (3) NYRAbets withdraws its application or it is denied; or (4) the Executive Director grants NYRAbets' application for a TPF license.
NYRAbets may facilitate wagering on live and simulcast racing upon receipt of a signed statement that provides that it agrees not to accept wagers in the State of Michigan without a license. NYRAbets must comply with the Act, the Rules, and Executive Director Orders. Failing to comply may result in sanctions including, but not limited to, revocation or suspension of the license exclusion from racetrack grounds, or a fine. NYRAbets understands that full licensure is conditioned on meeting the terms, conditions, and suitability standards contained in § 8(1)(d) and § 10(1)(e), (f) of the Act, and the Rules.
