



Michigan State Police Law Enforcement Information Network (LEIN) Basic LEIN Training



The Michigan State Police (MSP), Criminal Justice Information Center, LEIN Field Services Unit is now accepting registrations for Basic LEIN Operator Training.

Basic LEIN Operator Training is for agencies that have direct access to the LEIN and the National Crime Information Center (NCIC). This course targets new LEIN users, including:

- Dispatchers
- Law enforcement staff
- Corrections staff
- Probation staff
- Parole staff
- Prosecutor staff

Basic LEIN Operator Training will provide a basic understanding of LEIN and NCIC queries and responses, including the following:

- Access and dissemination policy
- Password use
- Wanted persons
- Missing persons
- Personal protection orders
- Stolen vehicles
- Driver and vehicle records
- Criminal history records
- Administrative messages

LEIN and NCIC policy requires all operators to be certified within six months of hire and re-certified every two years. The LEIN certification test is administered by the agency's Terminal Agency Coordinator (TAC) and will not be given during this class.

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, classes are only being scheduled for January through June at this time, and will all be held in a live online format using Microsoft Teams. Additional classes will be added to the schedule some time after the first of the year with the format to be determined.

Basic LEIN Operator Training Schedule:

- June 23, 2021 Live Online
- July 21, 2021 Live Online
- August 18, 2021 Live Online

There is no cost for this training. Class times are 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (EST). Attendees will be allowed into the Teams meeting beginning at 8:30 a.m. Registration is to be completed via [MI-TRAIN](#). The Course ID is 1094689.
