



## LAW ENFORCEMENT INFORMATION NETWORK Changes to Personal Protection Orders

This correspondence is being distributed to authorized Law Enforcement Information Network (LEIN) user agencies regarding updates to the Personal Protection Order (PPO) file in LEIN released on March 16, 2016. The changes are outlined below:

### Personal Protection Orders

Michigan Compiled Law (MCL) 600.2950a was amended in 2010 to allow petitioners to obtain a PPO restraining a person who has committed, or threatened, sexual violence against the petitioner. Orders classified as Non-domestic Sexual Assault PPO's can now be entered in LEIN using a charge code of 95.

Additionally, to coordinate with the current State Court Administrator's Office (SCAO) forms, PPO conditions have been added or removed from LEIN as outlined below.

The following PPO conditions were added (SCAO form number):

#### CC376:

DA5A1 – Is the spouse or former spouse of the petitioner, had a child in common with the petitioner, or is residing or has resided in the same household as the petitioner.

DA5A2 – Has or had a dating relationship with the petitioner.

#### CC376M:

DM7A1 – Is the spouse or former spouse of the petitioner, had a child in common with the petitioner, or is residing or has resided in the same household as the petitioner.

DMA2 – Has or had a dating relationship with the petitioner.

#### CC380:

SA5K - Posting a message through the use of any medium of communication, including the Internet or a computer or any electronic medium, pursuant to MCL 750.411s.

#### CC380M:

SM7K - Posting a message through the use of any medium of communication, including the Internet or a computer or any electronic medium, pursuant to MCL 750.411s.

SM13 - Other

The following PPO conditions were removed (SCAO form number):

#### CC376:

DA5 - The respondent is:

- the spouse or former spouse of the spouse or former spouse of the petitioner, had a child in common with the petitioner, or is residing or has resided in the same household as the petitioner;

- has or had a dating relationship with the petitioner.

**CC376M:**

DM7 - The respondent is:

- the spouse or former spouse of the spouse or former spouse of the petitioner, had a child in common with the petitioner, or is residing or has resided in the same household as the petitioner;
- has or had a dating relationship with the petitioner.

To accommodate existing PPO's, any of the above removed conditions that may be contained on an active PPO will remain on the active PPO.

Talon forms available through the Michigan Criminal Justice Information Network (MiCJIN) Portal LEIN and iServices have been updated to include the above PPO code changes, as well as all new condition forms for both adults and minors (including the new Sexual Assault Condition forms). Agencies not using Talon through the MiCJIN Portal should contact their vendor to ensure programming is in place to utilize this functionality.

An updated list of PPO condition codes is available as a supplement to this bulletin.

# Personal Protection Order Condition Codes

## PPO Conditions Domestic Violence CC376:

DA1 - This order is entered: (with/without) a hearing.

DA2 - A petition requested respondent be prohibited from entry onto the premises, and either the parties be married, petitioner has property interest in the premises, or respondent does not have a property interest in the premises.

DA3 - Petitioner requests an ex parte order, which should be entered without notice because irreparable injury, loss, or damage will result from delay required to give notice or notice itself will precipitate adverse action before an order can be issued

DA4 - Respondent poses a credible threat to the physical safety of the petitioner and/or a child of the petitioner.

DA5A1 - is the spouse or former spouse of the petitioner, had a child in common with the petitioner, or is residing or had resided in the same household as the petitioner.

DA5A2 - has or had a dating relationship with the petitioner.

DA6 - It is ordered: Name \_\_\_\_\_(Respondent) is prohibited from:

DA6A - entering onto property where petitioner lives.

DA6E6 - entering onto or remaining on property owned, leased, or occupied by the petitioner.

DA6E2 - Appearing at the workplace or residence of the petitioner.

DA6E4 - contacting the petitioner by telephone.

DA6F - interfering with petitioner's efforts to remove his/her children/personal property from premises solely owned/leased by respondent.

DA6G - threatening to kill or physically injure

DA6H - interfering with petitioner at his/her place of employment or education or engaging in conduct that impairs his/her employment or educational relationship or environment.

DA6I - having access to information in records concerning a minor child of petitioner and respondent that will reveal petitioner's address, telephone number, or employment address or that will reveal the child's address or telephone number.

DA6J - purchasing or possessing a firearm

## PPO Conditions Domestic Violence Minor CC376M:

DM1 - This order is entered: (with/without) a hearing.

DM2 - A petition requested respondent be prohibited from entry onto the premises, and either the parties are married, the petitioner has property interest in the premises, or respondent does not have a property interest in the premises.

DM3 - The respondent is less than 18 years of age, is unemancipated, and is not the minor child of the petitioner.

DM4 - The petitioner is less than 18 years of age, is unemancipated, and is not the minor child of the respondent.

DM5 - Petitioner requests an ex parte order, which should be entered without notice because irreparable injury, loss, or damage will result from delay required to give notice or notice itself will precipitate adverse action before an order can be issued

DM6 - The respondent poses a credible threat to the physical safety of the petitioner and/or a child of the petitioner.

DM7A - is the spouse or former spouse of the petitioner, had a child in common with the petitioner, or is residing or had resided in the same household as the petitioner.

DM7B - has or had a dating relationship with the petitioner.

FA3 - Petitioner requests an ex parte order, which should be entered without notice because irreparable injury, loss, or damage will result from delay required to give notice or notice itself will precipitate adverse action before an order can be issued  
FA4 - The respondent has been convicted of sexual assault against the petitioner as follows:  
FA4A - The petitioner is a minor and the respondent has been convicted of furnishing obscene material to the petitioner in violation of MCL 750.142 or a substantially similar law from another jurisdiction as follows:  
FA4B - The petitioner has a reasonable apprehension of sexual assault because the respondent has sexually assaulted the petitioner or threatened the petitioner with sexual assault.  
FA4C - The petitioner is a minor and the respondent has furnished obscene material to the petitioner.  
FA5 - It is ordered: Name \_\_\_\_\_ (Respondent) is prohibited from:  
FA5A - entering onto property where petitioner lives.  
FA5B - entering onto property at  
FA5C - threatening to sexually assault, kill, or physically injure the petitioner or a named individual.  
FA5D - purchasing or possessing a firearm  
FA5E - interfering with petitioner's efforts to remove his/her children/personal property from premises solely owned/leased by respondent.  
FA5F - interfering with petitioner at his/her place of employment or education or engaging in conduct that impairs his/her employment or educational relationship or environment.  
FA5G - following or appearing within sight of the petitioner.  
FA5H - approaching or confronting the petitioner in a public place or on private property  
FA5I - appearing at the workplace or the residence of the petitioner.  
FA5J - entering onto or remaining on property owned, leased, or occupied by the petitioner.

### **Sexual Assault Conditions CC396M:**

FM1 - This order is entered: (with/without) a hearing.  
FM2 - A petition has been filed requesting an order under MCL 600.2950a(2)  
FM3 - The respondent is less than 18 years of age, is unemancipated, and is not the minor child of the petitioner.  
FM4 - The petitioner is less than 18 years of age, is unemancipated, and is not the minor child of the minor respondent.  
FM5 - Petitioner requests an ex parte order, which should be entered without notice because irreparable injury, loss, or damage will result from delay required to give notice or notice itself will precipitate adverse action before an order can be issued  
FM6 - The minor respondent has been subject to an order of disposition or other adjudication based on the sexual assault of the petitioner as follows:  
FM6A - The petitioner has a reasonable apprehension of sexual assault because the minor respondent has sexually assaulted the petitioner or threatened the petitioner with sexual assault.

FM6B - The petitioner is a minor and the minor respondent has been subject to an order of disposition or other adjudication based on furnishing obscene material to the petitioner in violation of MCL 750.142 or a substantially similar law from another jurisdiction.

FM6C - The petitioner is a minor and the minor respondent has furnished obscene material to the petitioner

FM7 - It is ordered: Name \_\_\_\_\_ (Respondent) is prohibited from:

FM7A - entering onto property where petitioner lives.

FM7B - entering onto property at

FM7C - threatening to sexually assault, kill, or physically injure the petitioner or a named individual.

FM7D - purchasing or possessing a firearm

FM7E - interfering with petitioner's efforts to remove his/her children/personal property from premises solely owned/leased by respondent.

FM7F - interfering with petitioner at his/her place of employment or education or engaging in conduct that impairs his/her employment or educational relationship or environment.

FM7G - following or appearing within sight of the petitioner.

FM7H - approaching or confronting the petitioner in a public place or on private property

FM7I - appearing at the workplace or the residence of the petitioner.

FM7J - entering onto or remaining on property owned, leased, or occupied by the petitioner.

FM7K - contacting the petitioner by telephone.
