## Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Exemption Certificate

Certificate No. **3-19-0002** Amended

Pursuant to the provisions of Public Act 146 of 2000, as amended, the State Tax Commission hereby issues an Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Exemption Certificate for the commercial real property, as described in the approved application, owned by **Battle Dog, LLC**, and located at **64 W Michigan Avenue, City of Battle Creek**, County of Calhoun, Michigan.

This certificate provides the authority for the assessor to exempt the commercial property for which this Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Exemption Certificate is in effect, but not the land on which the rehabilitated facility is located or the personal property, from ad valorem taxation. This certificate further provides the authority to levy a specific tax known as the Obsolete Properties Tax.

This certificate, unless revoked as provided by Public Act 146 of 2000, as amended, shall remain in force for a period of **12 year(s)**;

**Beginning December 31, 2019, and ending December 30, 2033.**

The real property investment amount for this obsolete facility is **\$3,653,622**.

The frozen taxable value of the real property related to this certificate is **\$37,138**.

The State Treasurer **has excluded** from the specific tax **one-half of the mills levied for local school operating purposes and one-half of the state education tax** to be levied for this certificate for a period of six years, beginning **December 31, 2019** and ending **December 30, 2025**.

**Certificate Effective Date: May 13, 2019.**

This amended Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Exemption Certificate is issued on October 14, 2019 and supersedes all previously issued certificates.
