The State Tax Commission (Commission) has received a resolution from the City of Detroit regarding the revocation of Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Certificate Number 3-16-0006, issued to 2051 Rosa Parks LLC, located at 2051 Rosa Parks Boulevard in City of Detroit.

Public Act 146 of 2000, the Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Act (Act), provides for the revocation of a certificate by the legislative body of the qualified local governmental unit. The Act does not require further action by the Commission following the revocation by a qualified local governmental unit. However, the Commission acknowledges the revocation of Certificate number 3-16-0006 as approved by the City of Detroit and the resolution will be placed in the Obsolete Property Rehabilitation Number 3-16-0006 file for future reference.

A party aggrieved by the issuance, refusal to issue, revocation, transfer or modification of this exemption certificate may appeal a final decision by filing a petition with the Michigan Tax Tribunal, www.michigan.gov/taxtrib, within 35 days. MCL 205.735a (6).
