Michigan Employment Security Act

Wagner-Peyser (WP) Act of 1933, as amended by the Workforce
Innovation and Opportunity Act of 1998

Background: The MWAs received funding in the amount of \$830,760 to provide
RESEA activities to Unemployment Insurance claimants. This program
replaces the mandatory profiling requirements. The goal of this program is
to provide customized services to claimants deemed most likely to exhaust
their Unemployment Insurance benefits.

Policy: The expiration date of this policy has been changed to “ongoing,” with the
understanding that this program will continue after all funding has been
exhausted.

Action: **Allocations and Funding**

MWAs will submit a Budget Information Summary with a new ending date of June 30, 2016, to the Welfare Reform/Wagner-Peyser e-mail at WDA-WR-WP@michigan.gov within 30 days of the issuance of this policy.

Any unspent money may be carried into calendar year 2016. The current allocations will remain the same. If additional funding is announced, the MWAs will be notified.

All other requirements from WDA PI: 15-22, dated September 21, 2015, and WDA PI: 15-22 Change 1, dated October 15, 2015, remain in effect.
