

Michigan High School Equivalency (HSE) Testing Program Fact Sheet

Pursuant to Michigan Public Act 249 of 2016, Section (4)(6), the three (3) high school equivalency tests in Michigan shall include the **GED®**, **HiSET®**, and **TASC** assessments.
