Section 604(1)(a) the number of days of care purchased from state hospitals and centers.

Information is displayed by persons with mental illness (MI) and persons with developmental disabilities (DD). Alternative placements are the following residential programs: partial hospitalization, specialized residential, supported independent housing, and crisis residential for persons with mental illness; and specialized residential for persons with developmental disabilities.
