

**REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE**  
**Pursuant to P.A. 63 of 2011**  
**Section 925**  
**Administrative Segregation Report**

Section 925: By March 1, 2012, the department shall report to the senate and house appropriations subcommittees on corrections, the senate and house fiscal agencies, and the state budget director on the number of prisoners in administrative segregation between October 1, 2003 and September 30, 2011, and the number of prisoners in administrative segregation between October 1, 2003 and September 30, 2011 who at any time during the current or prior prison term were diagnosed with a serious mental illness or a developmental disorder and the number of days each of the prisoners with a serious mental illness or a developmental disorder have been confined to administrative segregation. As used in this section:

(a) "Administrative segregation" means confinement for maintenance of order or discipline to a cell or room apart from accommodations provided for inmates who are participating in programs of the facility.

(b) "Serious mental illness" means that term as defined in section 100d(3) of the mental health code, 1974 PA 328, MCL 333.1100d.

The first six rows of the table below summarize data that had been presented in the past for this boilerplate report, which had been compiled by IT support for the Corrections Mental Health Program in the Department of Community Health, based on cumulative and individual case data for serious mental illness (SMI) or development disorder (DD) as identified on the mental health caseload. These past data rows are shaded in grey.

Last year, it was determined that there were some flaws in that automated reporting, so the unshaded rows in the table include a refresh of the last two shaded years of data to reflect more accurate information for those overlapping years. Please also be advised that the most recent data reflects better information resulting from the clean up of some outdated cell designator data on the MDOC enterprise IT systems that had no longer accurately identified some administrative segregation housing for the analysis. The source data for all of the columns in the unshaded rows is now the MDOC Health Management Information System (HMIS) within the Corrections Management Information System (CMIS).
