Pursuant to Public Act 166 of 2020
Article 2, Section 802(2)
Health Care – Pharmaceutical Expenditures

Sec. 802(2). By April 1, the department shall provide the senate and house appropriations subcommittees on corrections, the senate and house fiscal agencies, the legislative corrections ombudsman, and the state budget office with a report on pharmaceutical prescribing practices, including a detailed accounting of expenditures on antipsychotic medications, and any changes that have been made to the prescription drug formularies.

Detailed Accounting of Expenditures on Antipsychotic Medications

Year-to-Date expenditures for antipsychotic medications for October 2020 to February 2021 are \$702,859.93. The monthly breakdown of expenditures is:

October 2020	\$152,755.47
November 2020	\$150,942.73
December 2020	\$145,477.37
January 2021	\$144,152.65
February 2021	\$109,531.71

Fiscal Year 2020 (October 2019-September 2020) antipsychotic medication expenditures totaled \$2,065,218.38

Changes Made to the Prescription Drug Formularies

The Michigan Department of Corrections, Bureau of Health Care Services maintains a Clinical Formulary reference book which was first approved on September 20, 2006 and most recently updated on November 18, 2020.
