Section 617 of 2014 Public Act No. 252 requires the Department of Human Services (DHS) to report the following information:

- *The number and percentage of public assistance recipients, categorized by type of assistance received, who were no longer eligible for assistance because of their status in the law enforcement information network.*

During the period January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014, a total 2175 recipients were determined no longer eligible for assistance because of their status in the law enforcement information network. Please see the attached report, which contains the information per public assistance program.
