Subject was shooting at a coyote running across a field and missed. The bullet struck a house on the other side of the coyote. No one was injured, property damage.

Subject was tracking a wounded deer with several family members. When the shooter observed the deer, he attempted to shoot it with a handgun, firing several rounds. One of the rounds struck the victim, causing fatal injuries.

Subject was hunting from a make-shift ground blind. Upon trying to move, the firearm caught on some burlap used for cover and went off. The round struck the subject in the left foot.

Subject was found alone in an elevated deer blind with a single gunshot wound to the chest. His pistol was located on the floor, still in the holster, which had an exposed trigger guard.

Subject accidentally discharged his firearm while in a treestand. He shot himself in the ankle.
