(FY2016 Appropriation Act - Public Act 84 of 2015)

February 15, 2016

Sec. 708(2). The department shall submit a report to the house and senate appropriations subcommittees on the department budget, the house and senate fiscal agencies, and the house and senate policy offices by February 15, of the current fiscal year on the number of counties that fail to submit a service spending plan by October 1, and the number of service spending plans not approved by December 15.

County Service Spending Plans

Due to the integration and interface of the Child Care Fund annual plan, budget and monthly reimbursement process into the Michigan Statewide Automated Child Welfare Information System (MiSACWIS), the final deadline for counties to submit their spending plans was extended to November 1, 2015, for FY 2016. In numerous cases, the department requested more specific program descriptions and other changes to ensure programs met eligibility criteria for reimbursement, prior to approval.

All county service spending plans were approved by January 15, 2016.
