

Bus Inspection Report to the Michigan Legislature School Year 2013-2014

This report is published in accordance with the Michigan Department of State Police appropriation of Public Act 252 of 2014. Section 602 (7) “Commercial Vehicle Enforcement” mandates an annual report to the subcommittees and the Senate and House Fiscal Agencies regarding the inspections conducted under Michigan Compiled Law 257.1839.

The Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Division conducts the annual inspection requirements in accordance with the school year calendar, September 1 through August 31; therefore, this report is being submitted for the school year of September 1, 2013 through August 31, 2014.

Inspection Statistics

Definitions:

- Passed Inspection: The bus was found to have no defects the first time it was inspected during that school year.
- Yellow-Tagged: A bus that was found to have a defect requiring repairs to be made within 60 days, but still could be used to transport pupils to and from school and school-related events.
- Red-Tagged: A bus that was found to have a defect preventing the bus from being used to transport pupils to and from school and school-related events until repairs were made.
