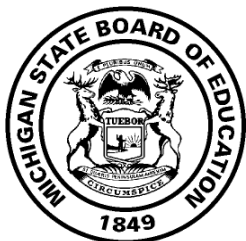
WHEREAS, school support staff add to the credibility of our neighborhood public schools through their accomplished expertise and high quality work; and
