NOTICE TO CDL TESTERS: NEW CDL INSPECTION MEMORY AID

The Michigan CDL Manual (TS-004) has been reprinted. The new manual has several updates, including a new introduction and a completely new Vehicle Inspection Memory Aid, which is in Appendix C of the manual.

The new memory aid meets the test standards prescribed by Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations. Old versions of the manual have been removed from the warehouse and MDOS branch offices were instructed to immediately order the new manual and stop distributing the old version of the manual.

CDL testing businesses should discard old copies of the memory aid and distribute only the new version of the memory aid. Customers who come to the test site without a memory aid should be offered a copy of the new memory aid. Examiners and other employees of testing businesses may not offer the old version.

Some test applicants who were issued their CLP prior to October 1 will not have the latest version of the memory aid. Applicants who bring the old memory aid may use it for their vehicle inspection on the CDL skills test. **Examiners are not required to determine whether an applicant should or should not have received the new memory aid and may continue allowing use of the old memory aid at this time.**

Use of the old memory aid will be allowed for six months, which is the eligibility period of the CLP issued to applicants who have the old version of the manual and memory aid. Driver Testing Section expects to notify CDL testing businesses in early 2017 that examiners must stop allowing use of the old memory aid, beginning May 1, 2017.
