Background: Per PI 15-33, issued December 23, 2015, and effective

Governments and West Michigan Works!.

Policy: Effective July 1, 2016, the Workforce Development Agency will assume

responsibility for delivering services under the MSFW Outreach Program.

Action: MSFW Outreach Program-Wagner-Peyser 7(b) grant funds that remain

unexpended on June 30, 2016, will be recaptured by the WDA.
