Background: The Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 (the Act) provides that state agencies be

given maximum flexibility in designing Employment & Training programs for individuals receiving food assistance. The FAE&T Program provides

participants opportunities to gain skills, training, or experience to improve

their ability to obtain regular employment and increase

self-sufficiency. The State of Michigan operates a voluntary FAE&T Program, which is jointly administered by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services and the Workforce Development Agency (WDA).

Additional Program Operations funding is available as a result of the passage of the Agriculture Improvement Act of 2018. This policy distributes such funding. In addition, the WDA has identified General Fund/General Purpose (GF/GP) funds and is allocating such for supportive services.

Policy: Allocations

The FY 2019 funding was allocated by formula to the eleven MWAs operating an FAE&T Program. In response to the MWA requests, funding has been reallocated as indicated. The WDA has de-obligated \$5,000 for FY 2019 FAE&T program operations from Southeast Michigan Community Alliance (SEMCA). Redistribution of funding and additional funding has been allocated to Berrien/Cass/Van Buren, Capital Area, Macomb/St. Clair, and Southeast Michigan Consortium. In addition, \$4,000 in FAE&T supportive services funding has been de-obligated from SEMCA and redistributed to Southeast Michigan Consortium. The WDA has allocated \$13,800 in GF/GP funding to Capital Area and Southeast Michigan Consortium. All funding is described in Attachment A located at the end of this policy.

Use of Funds

The FY19 GF/GP FAE&T funding may not be used until the MWA has expended the federal FAE&T funding allocated for supportive services.

Supportive Services

The following items are **not allowed** to be paid for with FAE&T funds:

- Automobile insurance.
- Automobile ownership/operator taxes (tag and title).
- Automobile purchase.
- Bad debt.
- Drug/alcohol counseling or therapy.
- Food staples and groceries.
- Living stipend.
- Mental health treatment.
- Personal computers.
- Relocation expenses.
- Student loans, fees, penalties, or fines.

 Expenditures to support employment that was obtained prior to enrollment in FAE&T.

Action:

The MWA officials whose funding has changed shall prepare and submit a Budget Information Summary forms within 30 days of the official date of this policy to TED-TSDIV@michigan.gov.

All other requirements of PI 18-34 remain in effect.
